**Moriah relies on the generosity of donors like you to ensure that children from less privileged backgrounds are able to receive a wonderful Moriah education.**

A total of \$1,057,233\* was received from our generous bursary donors, enabling the Foundation to continue to provide forty-nine (49) Jewish children with access to a Moriah College education in 2019. A further ten (10) students were awarded bursaries in 2019 and commenced at Moriah College in January 2020.

Without the generous support of Foundation members these families would not be able to afford a Moriah education for their children. The Moriah Foundation Bursary Program has an

immeasurable impact on each of these children and their families throughout their lives.

The bursary grant covers an agreed portion of tuition expenses, ranging from 50 to 100 per cent, depending upon the individual circumstances. The recipient is means-tested according to the criteria established by the College Principal together with the Financial Assistance Committee of the Moriah Board. The family's commitment to Jewish education is also taken into account.

Moriah College offers academic and co-curricular scholarships, which are awarded solely on academic, musical or sporting criteria, whilst bursaries are awarded on a financial needs basis.

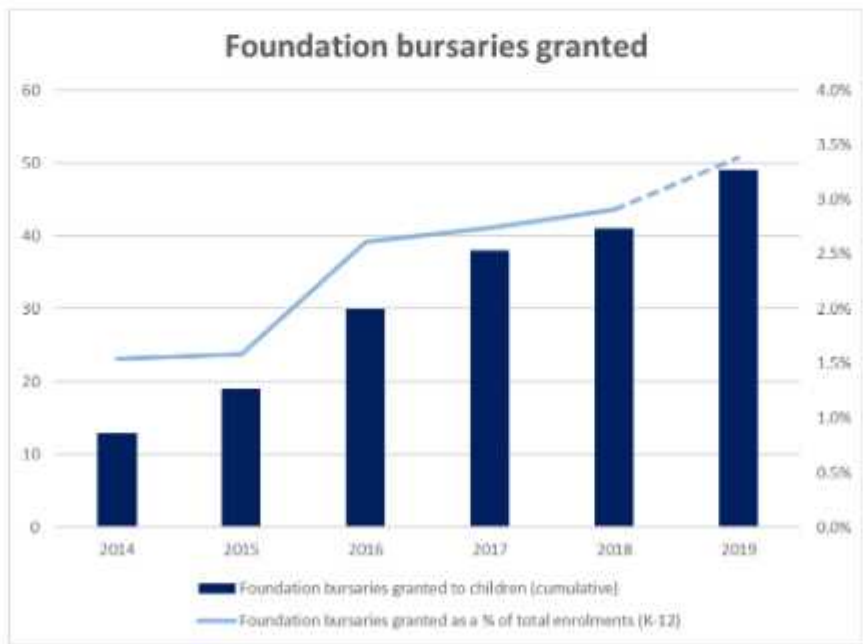
