Making an impact

Every year, the demand for bursaries in our community increases as more families, desperate for their children to receive a Moriah education, reach out for our help.

With your incredible support, in 2021 an extraordinary 54 children enrolled were supported with Moriah Foundation Bursaries.

It is truly inspirational to see the difference our donors such as yourselves are making, offering our bursary families access to an exceptional education, equipping them with Jewish knowledge and values, pride in their Jewish identity, and a deep sense of belonging.

As The Moriah Foundation enters into our second decade, and with your transformative support, we remain focused on assisting as many children as possible to access a Moriah education, and supporting Moriah College to remain a leading school of choice, delivering exceptional education and opportunities to all our students.

Many parents want to enrol their children in Moriah, but without the provision of a bursary, their financial circumstances make it impossible for them to do so.

The Moriah Foundation Bursary Program enables more Jewish children to receive

a Jewish education by providing fee discounts ranging from 50% to 100% depending on family circumstances. Bursaries are generally awarded for the duration of Primary or High School, or for the child's entire schooling from Year K until the completion of Year 12.

All applicants are required to complete a detailed and comprehensive means tested and equity-based assessment of the family's financial situation, as well as demonstrate their commitment to Jewish education. Bursaries are not awarded on the basis of academic criteria. The utmost care is taken to ensure the process is confidential and dignified, yet robust and fair.

Recipients do not generally need to reapply each year, unless their financial circumstances change.

This rigorous and equitable process ensures that bursaries are allocated to families who are in the greatest financial need, and who will value the opportunity to receive the exceptional education provided by Moriah.

We are grateful to you and our other bursary donors who have enabled tens of children a year to receive the life-changing gift of a Moriah education and all its offerings, a gift that can change the entire trajectory of a child's life.

Thank you for doing something so kind, that comes without personal acknowledgment from us to you. This is the most selfless act of giving and I am so humbled by it.

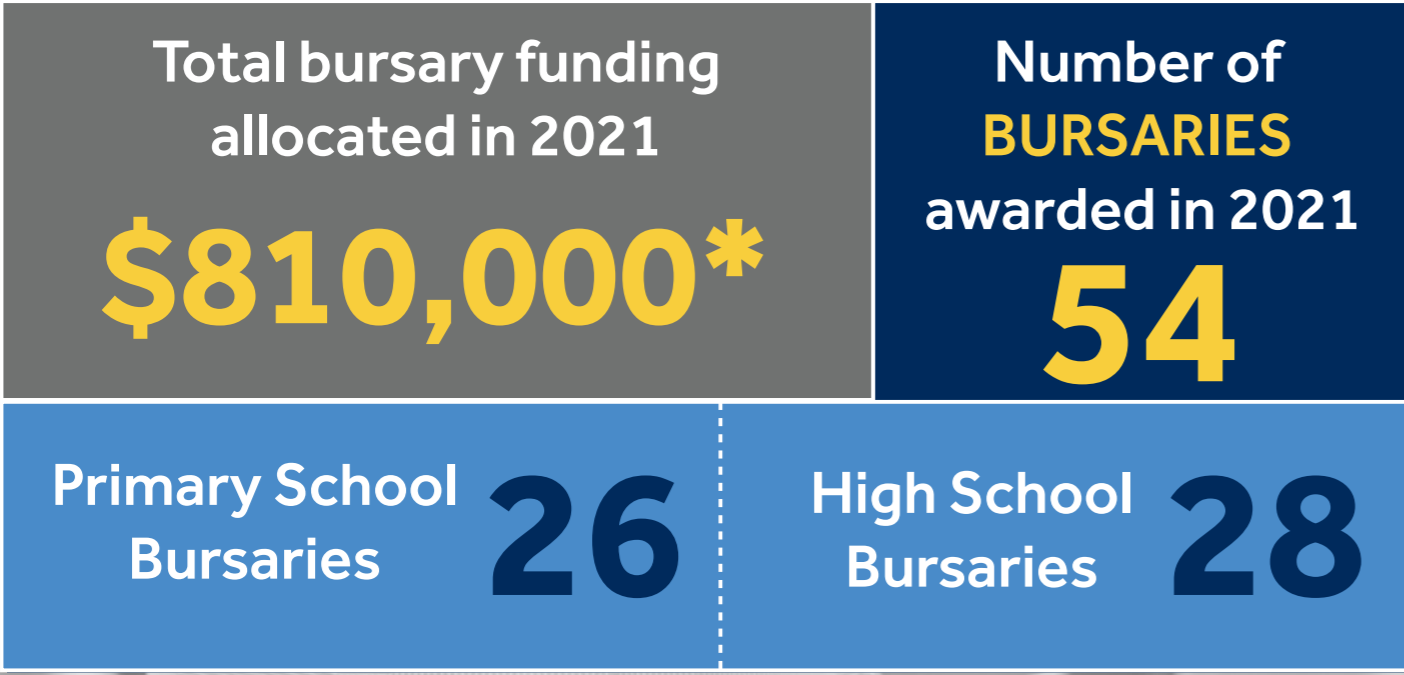
My daughter is making the most of every opportunity and we promise to give back to the school in our own way.

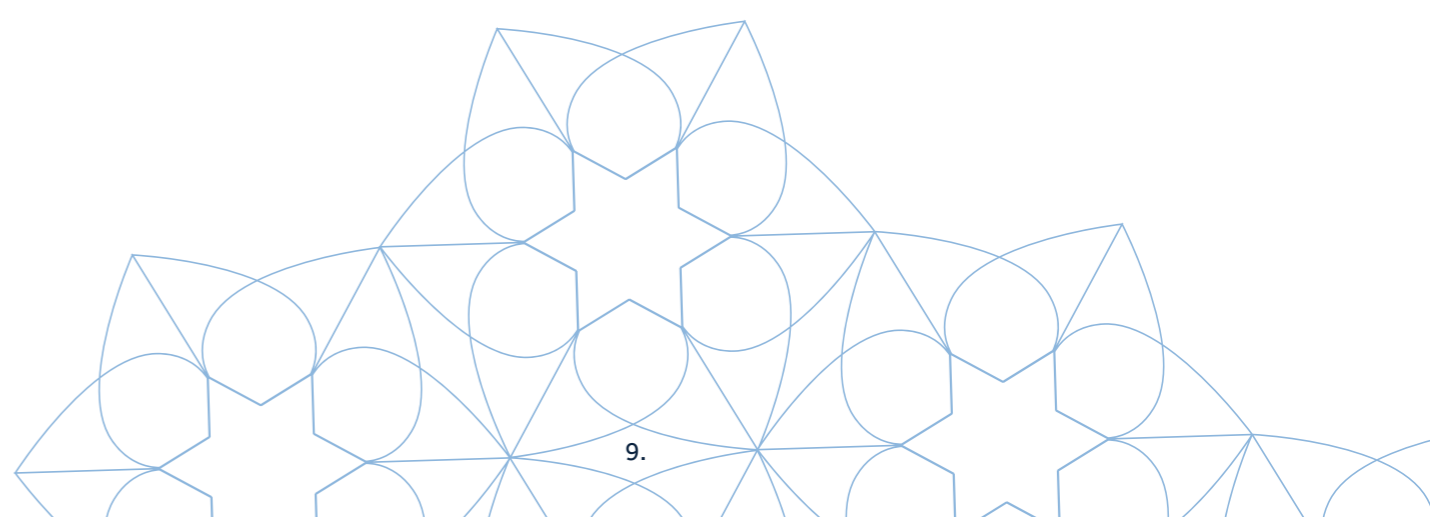
